2. PROPOSED LOCAL FOOD SOVEREIGNTY ORDINANCE

The purpose of this proposed ordinance is intended to provide residents increased access to local food, to support the ability of residents to produce, sell, purchase and consume locally produced foods, and to reduce governmental regulation of local foods to the extent permitted by and pursuant to Title 7 (Agriculture and Animals), Chapter 8-F: MAINE FOOD SOVEREIGNTY ACT 7 M.R.S. § 281 - § 286.
